



Notice Calling for Trustee Nomination

Nominations are called for one (1) Cultural Trustee position for the Ngāti Tama Ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trust Deed.

The process

- Nominations will be received by the Ngāti Tama Ki Te Waipounamu Trust office.
- The Ngāti Tama Ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trust will make recommendations to the board of the candidates that have been nominated.
- The Ngāti Tama Ki Te Waipounamu Trust Board will then appoint from that list of recommended candidates a new trustee for the Ngāti Tama Ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trust, at a Ngāti Tama Ki Te Waipounamu Trust Board Hui.

This vacancy arises due to retirement of Moetu Tuuta. The Term of this position will be from the date of vote for a term of three years, therefore the term of this position will be until 2019 (as per Clause 6.4 paragraph (a) of the Ngāti Tama Ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trust Deed).

Nominees must be eligible as per Clause 6.2 in the Ngāti Tama Ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trust Deed and make a legal declaration confirming this.

Nominations and acceptances must be received in writing and sent to the Ngāti Tama Ki Te Waipounamu Trust office no later than 5pm, 13th May 2016.

As per clause 6.2 (e) of the Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu Trust Deed, candidates must be able to demonstrate skills, knowledge, experience or achievements in one or more of the following:

- Te reo Māori
- Governance experience
- Community service
- Tikanga Māori
- Business, financial or legal skills
- Academic achievements

Nominees should include a brief description of the skills and experience they could bring to the cultural and governance of Ngāti Tama Ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trust to enable trustees to make informed decisions.
